

Boarding Houses



Boarding Houses can be a small home with only a few people living there or they can be huge houses, sometimes with many levels. Generally everyone has their own fully furnished room and living areas are communal. Full board is provided at some boarding houses which means you get 3 meals a day and other costs (eg gas, electricity, cleaning) are included in the rent. Make sure you ask what is included in the price, what's in the room and about any "house rules".
